4. Valleys are temporary

"There is wonderful joy ahead, even though the going is rough for a while down here." 1 Peter 1:6 (LB)

"Our troubles are short lived and their outcome is an eternal glory which outweighs them all." 2 Cor. 4:17

5. Valleys are purposeful

"... at the present you may be temporarily harassed by all kinds of trials. This is no accident - it happened to prove your faith..." 1 Pet. 1:6b-7 (Ph)

WHAT TO DO IN DARK VALLEYS

1. <u>Process</u> your feelings, <u>refuse</u> to be discouraged
